**Kentron Construction**, located in Kitimat, has been providing road construction services and concrete supply to Kitimat and the outlying area for more than 50 years. We are an operating unit of the YCS Holdings Ltd. group of companies, which delivers road building and other construction services in central and northwest BC.

Kentron Construction operates both a state of the art asphalt plant as well as a concrete plant in Kitimat. We also offer aggregate production and sales.

Kentron Construction offers a range of road construction services for residential, commercial and industrial projects. Our jobs range in scope from pothole patching and driveways to municipal work, MoT highways, heavy industrial and remote technical projects.

We are active in First Nations communities, where we have developed unique partnerships and have devised creative solutions to the problems that arise from working in remote locations. For example, in 2011, Kentron Construction paved the ferry terminal parking lot at Klemtu, 160 kilometres south of Kitimat. The village is accessible only by air or water, making it necessary to transport the asphalt by barge from Kitimat—a 35-hour ocean journey.

We are capable of supplying concrete and aggregates to projects both small and large. Kentron Construction successfully supplied concrete for the modernization project at the Rio Tinto Alcan smelter in Kitimat, delivering over 120,000 m<sup>3</sup> of high specification concrete and aggregates over three years.

As a group, YCS Holdings Ltd. which is a subsidiary of Terus Construction Ltd. is heavily involved in Green Construction. As an example, 95% of our asphalt plants throughout BC recycle 30% recycled asphalt products. We also will be completing a section of Solar Road for the City of Prince George as a demonstration to our capabilities and commitment to a green economy.
